
WILSON STUART SCHOOL EQUAL OPPORTUNITIES STATEMENT



Rationale

Wilson Stuart School promotes positive attitudes to Equal Opportunities and this is seen as an integral part of school life and not as a subject to be taught only through curriculum areas.

By Equal Opportunities we mean that every member of the school community is valued, respected and entitled to fairness of treatment REGARDLESS of <u>Race</u>, <u>Gender</u> or <u>Disability</u>

It is the responsibility of every individual to counter racism, sexism, negative attitudes towards disability and other discriminatory practices.

The effectiveness of the policy is measured by the way in which we implement it on a daily basis.

Curriculum content through syllabi, schemes of work and resources reflect culture diversity, minority groups, women and people with disabilities in a positive light.

All resources, both those produced by staff and those commercially available, should contain positive images and not reinforced stereotypical views. All new resources are checked before use by the staff responsible for acquiring them.

Modifications to curriculum are made to ensure equality of access.
