- Sound Bops and Cubase - Students are using new technology to improve access to the digital production and creation of music for pupils with physical needs
- Garage band is used in the Challenge Pathway to enhance music creation and offer up to date sound looping and sequencing.
- Open Orchestra has arrived at WS with Explore 1 using the brand-new Clarion.
- New Instruments in school - a bass guitar including Open Orchestra using a bass guitar for the first time.
- Keyboard lessons for Explore pathway students provided from charity OHMI and staff from Birmingham Music Service.
