How Cultural Capital is delivered at Wilson Stuart in our Inspire Pathway

Opportunities to practise priority areas identified in the PLG are delivered through a variety of activities and experiences on and off site with a range of professionals. Profiling is an important aspect for quality information collecting for our students. Parents contribute to our profiles to ensure that information is up to date and a true reflection of the student to enlighten all those involved with the student.

A range of activities are provided to enrich our students lives and practice their PLG's such as:

- Weekly sensory music sessions provided by Educational Services.
- Walks to our local park- Witton Lakes
- Some classes visit the library on a weekly basis to share their own life experiences through story sharing and also engage in sensory stories.
- Story sharing throughout the week where students share personal experiences with a wide range of students and staff.
- Music projects involving Welsh National Opera, Educational services, Creative services, Sound Scape
- Art projects across pathways for our 6th form cohort.
- Curriculum time is allocated to break time routines to ensure that we are giving adequate time to practise life skills such as eating and drinking, handwashing, preparing for meals, transitioning to the bathroom and engaging in processes with as much control and agency as possible.
- Weekly Forest School sessions
- Visits to other colleges and schools to develop relationships and generalise PLGs
- Trip to local shops to be involved in purchasing ingredients for cooking session.
- PMLD celebration days
- Whole school events and celebrations such as Red Nose day, Easter, Ramadan, Eid and Christmas.
- Half termly parents' workshops in class
