





# Wilson Stuart EYFS Pathway

## Focus Story 1




**PSED Focus**: My Family, Doing the right thing, building relationships, keeping safe, following rules.

CLL Focus: Developing a love of reading, developing interests and involvement in story telling, experiencing and learning new vocabulary.


## Focus Story 2

## Focus Story 3



**CLL Focus**: Developing a love of reading, developing interests, story telling, experiencing and learning new vocabulary.







# Wilson Stuart EYFS Pathway





During the Autumn 2 term, we will be exploring a variety of exciting mini topics with the children, many of which will be centered around significant events and celebrations. These include Remembrance Day, where we will discuss the importance of remembering those who served in the armed forces, Diwali, the Hindu festival of lights, celebrating new beginnings and the victory of light over darkness, and Bonfire Night, where we'll learn about the historical event of Guy Fawkes and enjoy discussions around fireworks safety. These activities will help broaden the children's understanding of different cultures, traditions, and historical events in a fun and engaging way.
